Foreign Minister of Luxembourg pays courtesy call on the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister

Minister of Foreign and European Affairs of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg His Excellency Mr. Jean Asselborn paid a courtesy call on the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister Mr. K P Sharma Oli this morning.

During the call on, discussions were held on a wide range of matters of mutual interests between the two countries. The Rt. Hon. Prime Minister appreciated Luxembourg for its cooperation extended to Nepal through regional and multilateral channels, including the EU.
