Minister for Foreign Affairs Hon. Mr. Pradeep Kumar Gyawali attended a video conference of the Foreign Ministers of Afghanistan, Bangladesh, China, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka on Joint Response to COVID-19 this afternoon.

In his address to the conference, Minister Gyawali stressed the need for enhanced level of regional and international cooperation for COVID-19 response and economic recovery.

During the meeting, H.E. Mr. Wang Yi, State Councilor and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China, announced to provide Nepal with an additional grant of medical equipment and materials equivalent to 5 million RMB to complement national efforts in fighting against COVID-19.

The Foreign Ministers agreed to strengthen pragmatic cooperation to combat COVID-19 pandemic, reinvigorate economic recovery and protect people's lives and livelihood.
